## Government as a Platform (GaaP) Opening data developments and research issues

Full professor in “ICT and Governance” and is chair of the Information and Communication Technology research group of the Technology, Policy and Management Faculty of Delft University of Technology. Dr. Janssen acted as the leading Expert for the European Union in the revision of European Interoperability Framework (EIF) related to the opening of data and data sharing.

He is co-editor-in-chief of Government Information Quarterly (GIQ), associate editor of International Journal of E-business Research (IJEER) and on the editorial board of Information Systems Frontiers (ISF).

### Abstract

More and more governments are opening their data for use by others. Government as a Platform (GaaP) is a recent phenomenon in which governments start developing smart platforms which can be used by application developers, users, citizens and others to deliver public value. GaaP provides the flexibility to connect to other systems, is able to integrate new functions and intelligence, provides collaboration tools and is able to share and disclose data. In this talk Prof. Janssen will discuss what GaaP is, provide examples, and outline future development and research opportunities.
